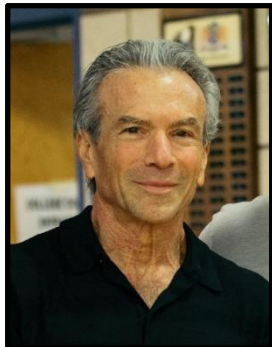




Amateur Events Panel

Hal Pastner

President, Bigfoot Hoops



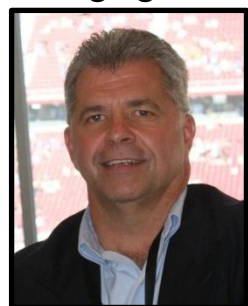
Biography:

Hal Pastner has been involved in youth basketball for over 30 years. Pastner's involvement operating events in the amateur sports industry started in 2001 when he took over the operation of a small Easter tournament – the Mae Fisher Easter Classic – that took place in Las Vegas. Pastner later expanded tournament offerings in Las Vegas and proceeded to form more events the next year, culminating in the “Main Event” which brought in teams from around the globe and high school players such as Kevin Durant and DeMar DeRozan. The event was telecast live by “The Best Damn Sports Show Period” on Fox and hosted by Chris Rose. The

high ratings for the tournament brought national attention to youth basketball in Las Vegas. Since then, Bigfoot Hoops has grown exponentially, and the 2018 Las Vegas Classic was the largest NCAA-certified youth basketball tournament ever produced in the United States, with teams from as far away as Australia, New Zealand, Europe and China participating. NBA players LeBron James, Chris Paul, Carmelo Anthony, Bradley Beal, Russell Westbrook, Shaquille O’Neal, Victor Oladipo, among others came to the Bigfoot Hoops event to watch their own sons and daughters play and to coach the grassroots programs they played for in high school, bringing further national attention and press to youth sports in Las Vegas. Pastner plans to continue to build and grow the youth basketball market with Las Vegas as the marquee destination.

Mike Millay

Biography:

Mike Millay is known as an early contributor to the now well-established sports tourism industry and has extensive experience in growing amateur sports. Millay helped to establish the Greater New Orleans Sports Foundation in 1990 as well as the National Association of Sports Commissions 1992 and is still active with several local and national sports organization boards of directors, such as the Central Florida Sports Commission and the National Council of Youth Sports. Millay also led the Walt Disney Company into the youth sports and tourism sector as one of the original architects of ESPN Wide

World of Sports. During his tenure with Disney, he oversaw the business development side of complex operations focused on driving facility growth, establishing new events and partnership activations. Before retiring, Millay was the longest-tenured executive at ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex at Disney. With 35 years of experience in the sports tourism and youth sports space, Millay is now focusing on youth sports programming as a partner at EngageMint, LLC (Fan Engagement), 3D Institute, LLC (Coaching Education) and Clancy's Sports Properties (Strategic Planning & Operational Execution).



Guy Hobbs

President, Nevada Youth Soccer Association



Biography: Guy S. Hobbs is the co-founder and managing director of Hobbs, Ong & Associates, Inc., an independent, full service, municipal advisory and financial consulting firm in Las Vegas. Hobbs' areas of expertise include tax policy and administration, budget and capital planning strategies, financial advisory services, debt management and operations management. He also has significant experience working with the State Legislature and several units of regional and local government. Hobbs served as chief financial officer for Clark County from 1983 through 1995 and was named public administrator of the year in 1986 by the Las Vegas Chapter of the American Society for

Public Administration. In addition to his role with Hobbs, Ong & Associates, Hobbs currently serves as the president of the Nevada Youth Soccer Association (NYSA). NYSA is the only comprehensive youth soccer organization in the state, and the official youth representative of the United States Soccer Federation in Nevada. NYSA serves competitors from ages 4 to 18, at various levels of competition from recreation to national team representation and provides the public with resources relating to hosting tournaments, coaching education and facilities. Hobbs is also a part owner of the Volvo Car Open WTA tour event in Charleston, SC, and has promoted professional soccer matches in Las Vegas. As a part of his position as President of the Nevada Youth Soccer Association, he also sits on the National Council of US Soccer.
